Revolve

Reusable items in good working order are accepted for free at the Revolve within Whytes Gully Waste Depot - such as furniture, sporting and camping goods, toys, clothes, blankets and linen, rugs, books, cutlery and crockery, lawn mowers, tools, washing machines, driers, fridges and building materials (eg wood, doors, windows, baths, etc). They

should be in reasonable condition and/or in working order to enable resale. Computers, televisions, mattresses, tyres and other electrical items, paint or household chemicals are not accepted. Items that are soiled, damaged or not working will be refused at the Revolve's/Council's discretion and shall be required to be disposed of as general waste with fees and charges applying.
